<u>Scope</u>


- Atherosclerotic occlusive disease
- Aneurysmal Disease
- Hemodialysis Access
- Venous stasis disease



CAROTID DISEASE

Indications for surgical intervention:


- Asymptomatic stenosis <u>></u>70%
- Symptomatic (CVA or TIA with stenosis <u>></u> 50%)



CAROTID DISEASE

Interventional Modalities

- Carotid endarterectomy
- Carotid stenting (CREST 2)
- TCAR



PERIPHERAL OCCLUSIVE DISEASE


Disabling claudication

Limb-threatening ischemia

PERIPHERAL OCCLUSIVE DISEASE

Open Reconstructions:

- Thromboendarterectomy
- Arterial Bypass





PERIPHERAL OCCLUSIVE DISEASE

Endovascular Methods:

- Balloon Angioplasty/Stent
- Transluminal Atherectomy




ANEURYSMAL DISEASE

Aortic Aneurysms

- Open reconstruction
- EVAR (Endovascular Aneurysm Repair)

Endovascular aneurysm repair (EVAR), abdominal aortic aneurysm (AAA)




HEMODIALYSIS ACCESS

Priority: all autogenous tissue


Forearm Loop Arteriovenous Graft




VENOUS STASIS DISEASE


Varicose Veins


